Deviations – System Emergencies

Central Maine Power Company has no deviations resulting from System Emergencies to post at this time.

18 C.F.R. § 358.7(g)(2) In the event of an emergency, such as an earthquake, flood, fire or hurricane, severely disrupts a transmission provider's normal business operations, the posting requirements in this part may be suspended by the transmission provider. If the disruption lasts longer than one month, the transmission provider must so notify the Commission and may seek a further exemption from the posting requirements.
