

RATE A-LM  
LOAD MANAGEMENT SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

This rate is available only to residential customers and to non-residential customers with monthly demands below 20 kW who have thermal energy storage devices and/or thermal storage heating systems integrated with resistance electric heating units (Eligible Devices). Devices that do not store thermal energy and thus would be adversely affected by periodic interruption will not be served under this rate. Service will be available under this rate for the time period between 8 p.m. on a given day and 7 a.m. on the following day.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

End use service will be single phase, alternating current, 60 hertz, at one standard secondary distribution voltage as described in the Company's Handbook of Requirements for Electric Service and Meter Installations and through one point of delivery.

METERING

The Company shall, at its expense, install and maintain appropriate metering for purposes of separately measuring kWh usage for the Eligible Devices. The Company shall have the right of access to the Customer's premises, at all reasonable times during which service is provided to the Customer, and on its termination, for the purpose of reading meters, or inspection and repair of equipment used in connection with providing service to the Customer, or removing its equipment.

BASIC RATE PER MONTH

Customers who began taking service under this Rate Schedule prior to May 1, 2011 are eligible for the following rate option through June 2012:

Service Charge	\$9.26
kWh Charge	\$0.011880/kWh

The components of this rate are subject to price changes approved by the Maine Public Utilities Commission.

MINIMUM CHARGE

The Minimum Charge is the Service Charge.

Customers who begin taking service under this Rate Schedule on or after May 1, 2011 may select one of the following rate options:

VARIABLE PRICE OPTION:

Service Charge	\$12.50
kWh Charges:	
On-Peak	\$0.105000/kWh
Shoulder	\$0.095000/kWh
Off-Peak	\$0.015000/kWh

The daily periods shall be as follows:

On-Peak	7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. - Monday - Friday
Shoulder	12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. - Monday - Friday
	7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Saturdays, Sundays, Holidays
Off-Peak	8:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

The components of this rate are subject to price changes approved by the Maine Public Utilities Commission.

The Minimum Charge under the Variable Price Option is the Service Charge.

MINIMUM CHARGE FOR FIXED PRICE OPTION

The Minimum Charge under the Fixed Price Option is the Service Charge.

The Company reserves the right to limit participation under this Fixed Price Option to 500 customers.

TRANSMISSION CHARGE

The transmission charges in accordance with Subsection 44.1 of the Terms & Conditions are included in the above rates.

CONSERVATION ASSESSMENT CHARGE

The conservation assessment charges in accordance with Subsection 49.1 of the Terms & Conditions are included in the above rates.

SHORT-TERM SERVICE CHARGE

Customers who take short-term service under the Variable Price Option will be billed for the first three months, or fraction thereof, \$37.50 per month in addition to the regular monthly electric delivery service rate (including the monthly minimum charge). Customers who take short-term service under the Fixed Price Option will be billed for the first three months, or fraction thereof, \$39.00 per month for the two-year option and \$40.50 for the three-year option in addition to the regular monthly electric delivery service rate (including the monthly minimum charge).

A credit equal to one-ninth of the amount of short-term service charges billed during the first three months of short-term service will be applied to a short-term customer's bill for each month, or fraction thereof, that the short-term customer's term of service exceeds three months. In no case will the total amount of such credits exceed the total amount of short-term service charges billed.

When seasonal service customers take service for less than twelve consecutive months, they will be considered to be short-term customers and their final bills will be adjusted to include any unbilled short-term service charges and credits.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SERVICE

1. All Eligible Devices will be controlled so that no electricity will be used except during the time period between 8 p.m. on a given day and 7 a.m. on the following day that service is made available.
2. The Company reserves the right to inspect all Eligible Devices.
3. Failure to abide by these requirements will result in the denial of service under this load management rate schedule. Service under this rate schedule may be reinstated only after an inspection has determined that the customer's installation complies with these requirements.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

If the customer requests that its kWh usage under this tariff be served by a Competitive Electricity Provider who is not serving the customer's current load, the Company will establish a separate account number for the load served under this tariff.
