

MEPCO ROLL-IN

MEPCO BUSINESS PRACTICES FOR GRANDFATHERED TRANSMISSION SERVICE AGREEMENTS (“MGTSAs”)

Effective December 1, 2008:

- Schedule 20B of the ISO-NE OATT is deleted and MEPCO Transmission Facilities classified as PTF
- Service provided pursuant to Schedules 8 and 9 of the ISO-NE OATT
- MEPCO OASIS node will only be accessible for historic information.
- Attachment H of the ISO-NE OATT provides list of MGTSAs
- MGTA terms and conditions pursuant to ISO-NE OATT Section II.45.
- MGTSAs will be posted as reservations by ISO New England, under a ‘new’ regional service type directly on the ISO-NE OASIS, for the NB interface (i.e. no longer a point to point service).
- [Attachment H-1](#) of the ISO-NE OATT is the agreement necessary for the sale or assignment of MGTSAs
- MEPCO will maintain and provide ISO-NE with a list of valid Attachment H-1 customers.

To Obtain MGTSAs Scheduling Rights:

- Must be listed in Attachment H or the Eligible Transmission Customer must execute a Service Agreement (Attachment H-1) with MEPCO in accordance with Section II.45.
- To obtain scheduling rights associated with a MGTA, a Transmission Customer (“Assignee”) must make arrangements with the MGTA holder (“Reseller”).
- The MGTA holder (“Reseller”) must post on OASIS the resulting sale or assignment of the MGTA including the number of megawatts sold and the associated rate in U.S. dollars (\$/mWh).
- Prior to posting the sale or assignment of the MGTA holder (“Reseller”) shall verify with MEPCO that the Transmission Customer has an executed Attachment H-1 Service Agreement with MEPCO.
- The posting of a valid sale or assignment will result in a confirmed OASIS reservation.
- MEPCO will notify the ISO-NE of any new valid Attachment H-1 customers and any terminated Attachment H-1 customers via e-mail to the OSS Schedulers mailbox at TRANSMAIL@iso-ne.com. (common subject line: i.e. MGTA H-1). This e-mail shall also contain the listing of all valid Attachment H-1 customers. Notification of new valid Att. H-1 customers must be provided to ISO-NE prior to noon the day before the Operating Day in which the external transaction and MGTA are expected to be scheduled. MEPCO will process the Eligible Transmission Customer’s requests during normal business hours Mon-Fri from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00p.m. In order to comply with ISO-NE’s scheduling timeline, MEPCO must receive the Eligible Transmission Customer’s executed Attachment H-1 at least 24 hours prior to the “noon the day before the Operating Day” scheduling timeline. MEPCO will accommodate shorter notice requests received during normal business hours as reasonably practicable.
- MEPCO will have query rights to ISO-NE’s OASIS in order to perform the monthly billing for all MGTSAs.
- The Reseller will receive a credit for the amount paid to MEPCO by the assignee for service provided during the relevant monthly billing period.
