Information updated daily

The energy usage you see on the Interval UsageWeb site will be current as of midnight the previous day. For example, if today were Tuesday, your data would reflect usage up to 12:00 midnight Monday. The data is presented in several useful ways:

- 15-minute interval usage and demand day-by-day
- bar graph of daily kWh
- line graph of hourly demands day-by-day
- day with highest demand peak

You can view this information on your computer screen, or download and import it into your existing spreadsheet or energy-management software.

Shopping for electricity suppliers

Electricity suppliers will need your hourly usage data in order to offer a competitive price. You can download this information into a spreadsheet and provide it to potential suppliers on a disk or via e-mail. Once you have chosen and contracted with a supplier, they will also have access to your information online.
