### SECTION 8 RIGHTS, PERMITS AND APPROVALS

# 8.1 STREET PERMITS

The Company shall make, or cause to be made, applications for any necessary street permits, and shall not be required to provide service until a reasonable time after such permits are granted.

# 8.2 PROCUREMENT BY CUSTOMER

Customers applying for service or the construction of an extension may be required to secure to and for the Company, all necessary and convenient rights-of-way and all other necessary licenses and approvals and to pay the costs incident thereto.

### 8.3 TERMS AND RENTALS

When the premises of a customer are so located that he can be served only by facilities extending over the property of another, the customer shall accept service for such term as is provided in the permit or agreement covering the location and the maintenance of service equipment, and he may be required to reimburse the Company for any and all special or rental charges that may be made for such rights by said permit or agreement.

### 8.4 COSTS OF LICENSES, PERMITS AND APPROVALS

The customer will pay the costs associated with all licenses, permits and approvals required for the initial installation of services and extensions.
