

SECTION 16
TERMINATION OF SERVICE

16.1 TERMINATION NOTICE

Customers who wish to discontinue service must give the Company reasonable notice to that effect.

16.2 FINAL BILL

The customer is liable for service taken until proper notice is given the Company as provided and thereafter until the meter has been read but such liability shall not exceed seven (7) days from the time notice has been given. The final delivery service bill is then due and payable upon presentation.

16.3 NOTICE OF DISCONTINUANCE BY CUSTOMER

Notice to discontinue service prior to the expiration of a contract term will not relieve a customer from any minimum or guaranteed payment under any contract or rate.

16.4 COMPLETION OF TERM

If, by reason of any act, neglect, or default of a customer, the Company's service is suspended, or the Company is prevented from providing service in accordance with the terms of any contract it may have entered into with the customer, the monthly minimum charge for the unexpired portion of the contract term shall become due and payable immediately as liquidated damages in lieu of the anticipated returns from said contract.
