

The following charts display a 10-year history of Distribution, Transmission and Standard Offer service rates for each of our rate classes.

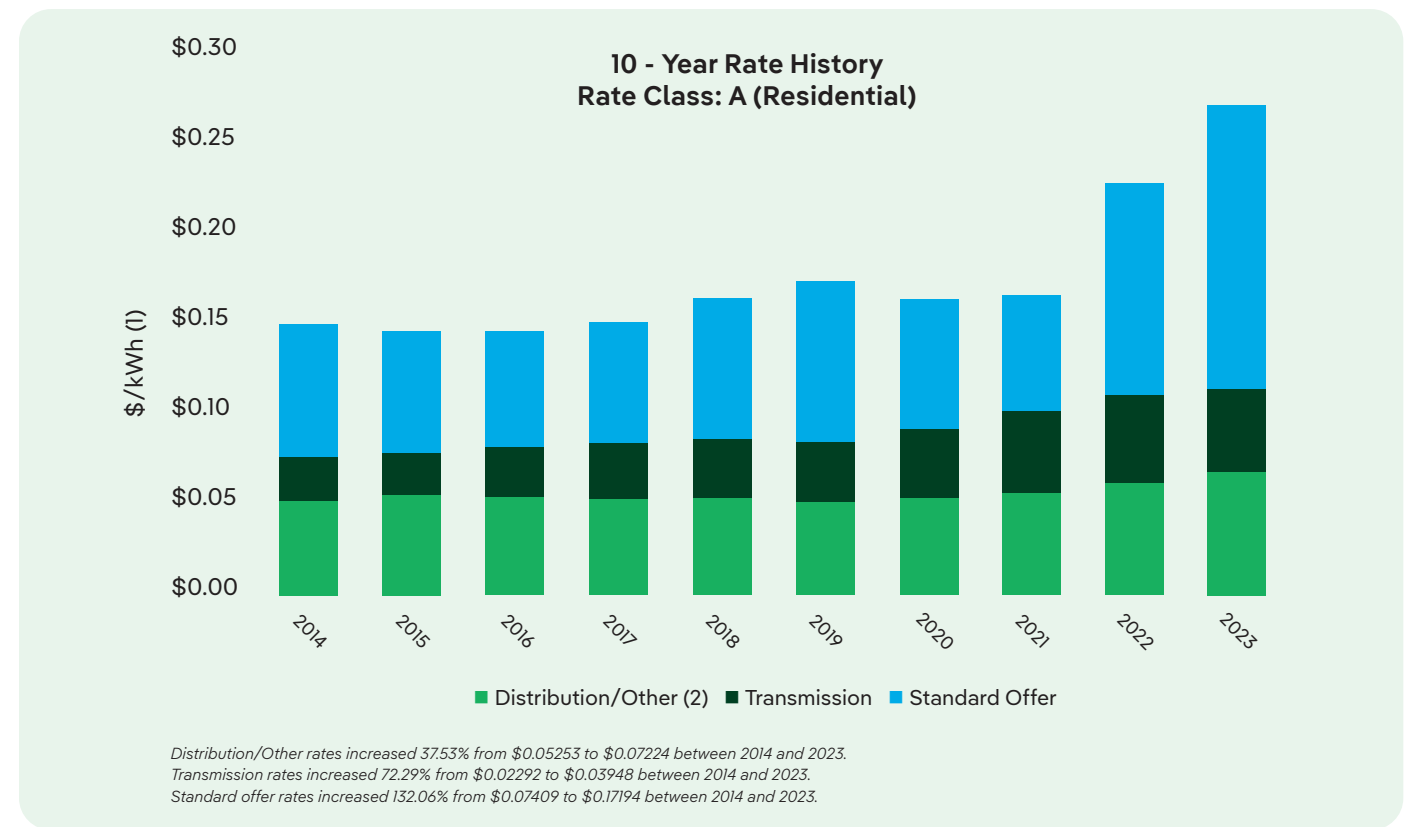
CMP Distribution/Other: This CMP service rate includes major investments in reliability through grid automation and modernization. Included in this rate are ‘Other’ public policy costs. These are not CMP charges and we do not profit from them. Public Policy costs are primarily associated with Maine’s solar incentive program, and state-mandated low-income assistance and energy efficiency programs.

Transmission: The transmission system moves electrical energy from a generating site, such as a power plant, to CMP’s substations for distribution to our customers.

Standard Offer: The Standard Offer is the supply portion of your bill and is not a CMP charge. The Standard Offer price is determined through an annual competitive bidding process administered by the Maine Public Utilities Commission (MPUC). We are required to bill and collect supplier charges and forward payments to suppliers on your behalf, in accordance with MPUC rules.

(1) \$/kWh are annual revenue per kWh amounts inclusive of all fixed, demand and per kWh charges.

(2) “Other” includes costs associated with state policy programs, including funding for Efficiency Maine, low-income programs, Net Energy Billing, and other renewable programs.
