

RATE A-SEASONAL
RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

These rates are available for Residential Service taken on a continuous year-round basis at one point of delivery who have an eligible device that is used to heat or supplement another heat source for their home or part of their home by transferring thermal energy from the outside with the use of the refrigeration cycle.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

End use service will be single phase, alternating current, 60 hertz, furnished at one standard secondary distribution voltage as described in the Company's Handbook of Requirements for Electric Service and Meter Installations.

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SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Pilot

A Pilot to test the effectiveness and adoption of this rate will be conducted from January 1, 2023. The Pilot will be limited to no more than 5,000 participants. Effectiveness and adoption of this rate will be assessed to design and adopt a replacement residential beneficial electrification rate or rates by the Commission.

2. Proof of Heat Pump Utilization and Ownership

Service under this rate will be contingent on customer verbally affirming ownership of a heat pump installed at the service location.

3. Eligibility to Participate

Customers electing to take service under this rate must take service under this rate on a year-round basis for a period of at least twelve months. If a customer opts out of this rate before the required twelve-month period is complete, that customer will not be eligible to participate in this rate for a period of one year from the date on which service under this rate has terminated. The enrollment period for this rate will end on December 31, 2024.

4. Military Veterans' Organizations

A military veterans organization qualified under the federal Internal Revenue Code of 1986, 26 United States Code, Section 501(c)(19), as amended, may request that electric delivery service to its facility be billed under the residential rates described in this rate schedule. The military veterans' organization must be billed directly for electric delivery service provided by the Company. A trust or foundation for a post or organization of past or present members of said military veterans' organization is not eligible for service under this electric delivery rate schedule.

This provision expires effective September 1, 2025. Upon expiration, the Company will place the customer on the non-residential rate that matches the customer's usage characteristics for the previous 12 months.

TERMINATION DATE

The pilot period will automatically terminate on the enrolled customer's billing cycle end-date in January 2026 and no later than January 31, 2026, unless otherwise renewed or modified by the Company and approved by the Commission.
