50.1 ELECTRIC LIFELINE PROGRAM ASSESSMENT

The electric lifeline program assessment charge included in the Basic Rate Per Month section of CMP's distribution rates schedules is provided below. The electric lifeline program assessment is charged on a kilowatt-hour basis. The rates presented below are applicable both to core rates schedules and to targeted rates.

The electric lifeline program assessment charge by core rate schedule is shown below:

Targeted Contracts and Programs:

The electric lifeline program assessment will be \$.000882 per kWh for targeted rate customers taking service at distribution voltages. There is no electric lifeline program assessment for targeted rate customers taking service at subtransmission and transmission voltages. For targeted contracts and programs where the price in the contract or program less transmission is less than the applicable electric lifeline program assessment, the electric lifeline program assessment is the difference between the price in the contract or program on a per kWh basis and transmission.
