

### Project Overview

As part of our commitment to provide safe, resilient service to our customers, Central Maine Power (CMP) is preparing to upgrade the Butlers Corner Substation located at 61 Stanley Road, Springvale. This project will also involve site work for the installation of a mobile substation at 263 Main Street, Springvale. The mobile substation is necessary to ensure reliable service while work is conducted at the existing substation.

CMP is working with communities and reaching out to neighbors to ensure that all improvements are performed safely and with minimal disruptions.

### Project Need

The purpose of this project is to upgrade the existing substation due to its age and condition, which no longer meets CMP standards. In addition, the use of more storm-resistant materials and upgraded smart communications devices increase the resiliency of our electric system. These upgrades will improve the reliability of service for over 4,200 area customers.

### Benefits to Customers

- Replacing structures that no longer meet CMP standards.
- Increased resiliency of the electric system.
- Improved reliability for area customers.

### Project Scope

#### Upgrades to the existing substation:

- Replacing outdated, wooden equipment with longer-lasting, more resilient steel structures.
- Expanding the substation yard and perimeter fence.
- Replacing the transformer pad.
- Upgrading smart communications devices.

#### Site preparation for the mobile substation:

- Installing a gravel foundation pad.
- Installing transmission and distribution structures.
- Erecting a perimeter fence.

### What to Expect During Construction

Work activity periods will comply with city ordinances. Work will be conducted during daylight hours, using existing access points.

#### Nearby property owners may experience:

- Typical construction noise, including backup beeping, should be expected. Abutters may hear the use of heavy equipment vehicles (bucket trucks, drilling equipment).
- Traffic disruptions, including the use of flaggers and temporary lane closures.
